## CHAP. 51.

An Act to extend to the Province of British Columbia "The Dominion Lands Acts."

[Assented to 8th April, 1875.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of Preamble. the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

1. The Act passed in the Session held in the thirty-35 Vic., c. 23 fifth year of Her Majesty's reign, and the Act passed in the and 37 Vic., Session held in the thirty-seventh year of Her Majesty's to British reign, and known as "The Dominion Lands Acts," and the Columbiaseveral provisions thereof, are hereby extended and shall apply to all lands to which the Government of Canada are new or shall at any time hereafter become entitled, or which are or shall be subject to the disposal of Parliament, in the Province of British Columbia, whether the title thereof be legally vested in Her Majesty the Queen for the Dominion of Canada, or howsoever otherwise.

## CHAP. 52.

An Act to amend "An Act respecting the appropriation of certain Lands in Manitoba."

[Assented to 8th April, 1875.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the third section of Preamble. the Act passed in the thirty-seventh year of Her Majesty's reign, and intituled: "An Act respecting the 37 V., c. 20. appropriation of certain Dominion Lands in Manitoba," and thereby to afford further facilities to parties claiming lands under the third and fourth sub-sections of the thirty-second section of the Act thirty-third Victoria, chapter three, to 33 V., c. 3. obtain Letters Patent for the same: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—
